

Recommendations When Using Fastum Gel

This information is provided as a reminder in addition to the Patient Information Leaflet contained in Fastum Gel box, please read the Patient Information Leaflet carefully.

When ketoprofen (contained in Fastum Gel) is applied to the skin, skin reactions (called photosensitivity reactions) have been reported after the exposure of the treated area to sunlight, even in cloudy weather, and including UV from solarium.

Therefore the following instructions should be followed before, during the use and for <u>2</u> weeks following the discontinuation of Fastum Gel:

- Do not expose treated areas to sunlight (even hazy) including UV from solarium and sunbeds.
- When outdoors, protect treated areas by wearing clothing even in cloudy weather.
- Wash hands thoroughly after each application of the product
- Do not use with an air-tight or water-tight dressing (i.e. do not bandage, wrap, or cover the area with a plastic dressing)
- Stop using Fastum Gel immediately if you experience any type of skin reaction and contact your doctor
